**A NEW CAPITAL CAMPAIGN**—As announced on July 18, Trinity has launched a new capital campaign to raise funds for our mortgage obligations and for larger renovation projects. Members will be asked to make a three year pledge commitment covering 2010, 2011, and 2012. The goal of the campaign is to raise \$500,000. We already have pledges for slightly over \$259,000, which is a great start. Members who have not yet pledged should have received information about the campaign in the mail. Pledges should be returned by August 15th if at all possible. Let's all do our part to help preserve Trinity's future as a place of vibrant ministry! **MISSION POSSIBLE FOR AUGUST**—Habitat for Humanity is a non-profit Christian ecumenical organization that seeks to eliminate poverty and homelessness from the world and to make decent shelter a matter of conscience and action. This global organization depends on volunteer labor and donations to build homes around the world, in partnership with the families who will occupy them. It has a unique funding model that uses payments made by recipient families to fund future homes. Trinity supports Habitat for Humanity with volunteer efforts, led by Charlie Swartzfager, who regularly leads our groups and lends his considerable carpentry talents to building local homes. Christine Brown, daughter of Pastor Tim and Lori Brown, has been working at a Habitat for Humanity affiliate in Michigan. Habitat is not a giveaway program. In addition to a down payment and monthly mortgage payments, homeowners invest hundreds of hours of their own labor (sweat equity) into building their Habitat house and the houses of others. Habitat houses are sold to partner families at no profit and financed with affordable loans. The homeowners' monthly mortgage payments are used to build still more Habitat houses. We have arranged to have audiologist, Tammy Stender, here to assist you. If you would like help setting your hearing aid so that it will receive the signal sent by our hearing loop system, please see Tammy after our 10 am service in the Gathering Space.

**THE HEARING LOOP SYSTEM** has been installed in our Sanctuary. This allows for direct broadcast of the worship service to your hearing aid. All T-coil equipped hearing aids will be able to receive this signal. Hearing aids differ in design. Yours may require selection of the T-coil mode. We have two direct reception headsets available for those who have non-T-coil equipped hearing aids or no hearing aid at all. We hope this enhancement is a blessing to you.
