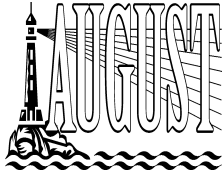


## August 15 —22, 2010 Announcements

**PAKISTAN**—Recent monsoon rains in Pakistan have caused the worst flooding in the country in 80 years. The floods, which began in late July, have claimed at least 1,600 lives, left more than 700,000 people homeless and have affected nearly 14 million Pakistanis, according to official reports. Lutheran World Relief (LWR) is working quickly with partners on the ground to deliver critical relief to people affected by this crisis. Throughout these years, severe droughts and water shortage severely plagued the country's agricultural system and crippled its food supply.
