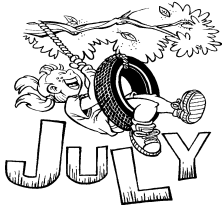

MISSION POSSIBLE FOR JULY: Shepherd's Lambs in Haiti. For over 25 years Shepherd's Lambs has been serving the people of Haiti through supporting pastors and congregations with food, clothing and the bringing of the Gospel. They have built and maintained two orphanages and lent support to two elementary schools and a sewing school. Recently the Lord has laid it on the hearts of those in Shepherd's Lambs to start a prison ministry. The organization was started by Audrey Volz, a cousin of Doug Felten, and is run from her home in Englewood, Florida. Doug & Elsa visited Haiti with Shepherd's Lambs in March 2009. They can tell you first-hand how deeply this ministry touches the lives of people in Haiti. All donations go directly to help people through food and clothing shipments, direct funding for the orphanages and schools, faith building mission trips and now relief supplies in the Port-au-Prince area.
