They have built and maintained two orphanages and lent support to two elementary schools and a sewing school. The organization was started by Audrey Volz, a cousin of Trinity member **Doug Felten**, and is run from her home in Englewood, Florida. Doug & Elsa visited Haiti with Shepherd's Lambs in March 2009. They can tell you first-hand how deeply this ministry touches the lives of people in Haiti. All donations go directly to help people through food and clothing shipments, direct funding for the orphanages and schools, faith building mission trips and now relief supplies in the Port-au-Prince area. All t-coil equipped hearing aids will be able to receive this signal. Hearing aids differ in design. Yours may require selection of the T-coil mode. You may not need to make any adjustment. For specific information pursuant to your hearing aid, please contact your audiologist. We have two direct reception headsets available for those who have non-T-coil equipped hearing aids or no hearing aid at all. We hope this enhancement is a blessing to you.
