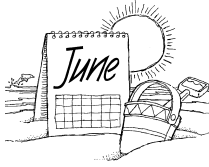

ALTAR FLOWERS are given by Ben & Kathy Bruhn to the Glory of God and in celebration of their wedding anniversary.

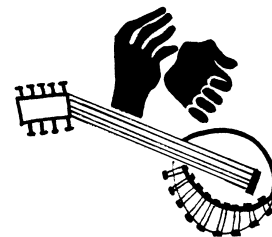
