TRINITY'S JUNE MISSION POSSIBLE: EACH MONTH, TRINITY SUPPORTS A DIFFERENT LOCAL MINISTRY PARTNER. It's what we call a "Mission Possible". Our June Mission Possible recipient is AMMPARO, the ELCA initiative to aid refugees and asylum seekers. At its outset in 2013, the Accompanying Migrant Minors with Protection, Advocacy, Representation and Opportunities effort focused on unaccompanied minors crossing the southern U.S. border. Today, however, its broader mission is aiding the tens of thousands of people camped in Mexico and along the border who are seeking asylum in the U.S., as well as refugees from other countries.

AMMPARO is engaged with other agencies and with Lutheran congregations around the country seeking sponsors and other aid for asylum-seekers while still providing support for unaccompanied minors in particular. And it continues its ongoing work to help address the root causes of the large-scale migration as well as to help safely re-settle asylum seekers if their asylum claims are rejected, as most are.

AMMPARO has been very active in advocating for policy changes that would make the asylum-seeker and refugee process more humane and end policies that forced the mass camping and detention that has taken place on the southern U.S. border. Recently, AMMPARO was added to the UN Migration Network Platform practices repository, indicating that a panel of UN migration experts determined that the AMMPARO strategy met the scope of the Global Compact on Migration key objectives. This is an affirmation of AMMPARO's work to promote the well-being of migrants and their communities.
