TRINITY'S MAY MISSION POSSIBLE: CONNECTIONS FOR THE HOMELESS — Our Mission Possible for May is Connections for the Homeless, the Evanston non-profit organization that helps those experiencing homelessness with dignity and compassion. It works to find homes for individuals and families, including those without homes and those on the verge of losing their homes.

This Housing First approach is nationally recognized as the best way to address homelessness. Connections currently operates the Margarita Inn as its year-round facility, housing individuals and families while it seeks to house them, something it has been able to do in 70% of its cases. It operates Hilda's Place as a drop-in center that helps with needs such as showers, laundry, food, clothing and storage but also with case management and health and wellness. A major expansion of Hilda's Place to a 30-to 50-bed shelter is now planned with the aid of a federal grant.
